1. By submitting a website address for free testing, you agree that you are the legal owner of the website being tested and/or you have received explicit permission from the legal owner or can represent owner on his behalf.
2. Only one web site will be tested per requester. The Website/URL which tested earlier under Free Service cannot be retested. Free service applied only for web site testing and not web-based application.
3. This free web site testing service is limited to identifying up to 5 defects and submitting them via a defect report.
4. Personal emails (AOL, Gmail, Yahoo, etc) are not accepted. The requester should provide his or her company email address.
5. The website needs to be accessible remotely through a QA or Production environment.
6. QA Mentor have authority to add Customer's logo in QA Mentor clients list after deliver test report of free service.
7. QA Mentor reserves all rights to change and update the Terms & Conditions at any point about Free Service.
8. QA Mentor have authority to stop FREE service any time without provide any prior notifications to users.
9. QA Mentor will not be liable to you in respect of any losses arising out of any event or events beyond our reasonable control.
